Spiritual and moral

We will learn to be considerate, tolerant and honest and develop a respect for ourselves and others.


Literacy

We will continue to develop our love of books, demonstrating how to handle books and how to follow text. We will begin phonic sessions, in which we will learn letter sounds using BBC Alphablocks characters to introduce each sound. Through our topic we will have a range of opportunities to write and make marks to communicate meaning.

Once Upon a Time...

Communication and language

We will learn to listen to others and respond to them appropriately. We will listen and respond to a variety of familiar stories and relate them to our own experiences.



Expressive arts and design

We will use role-play to develop our imaginations. We will dress up as story characters and re-tell stories in our own words and hot seat the characters to explore their feelings. We will begin to have weekly music sessions and also use songs and nursery rhymes to express ourselves creatively. Using Mary Mary Quite Contrary and her garden we will explore colour through drawing and painting.

Understanding the World

We will take part in school community events such as harvest using the traditional tale of The Little Red Hen. We will use the nursery rhyme Humpty Dumpty to explore materials and ask questions to solve the problem of how to protect him when he falls off the wall. We will begin to use laptops in the classroom to develop our mouse control.
