Learning beyond our Classroom

We will learn to show sensitivity to others' needs and feelings, especially as we explore through story, visits and role play some of the caring professions.

We will explore writing and reading through role play e.g. writing sentences about patients in our doctors surgery, instructions for how to look after pets in our vets and phone messages as we take calls in our role play fire station.



Understanding the World

We will learn about using the internet safely. We will talk about our environment and the people in it and recreate our High Street to explore through imaginative play. As we look at the role vets play within our community, we will learn more about the similarities and differences of living things.



Physical

We will use a range of throwing equipment we will improve our throwing and catching skills. We will also use a range of striking equipment such as tennis rackets, hockey sticks and cricket bats, to developing the correct grip and our aim.

Communication and language

We will listen to a range of adult visitors from our local community as they talk to us about their jobs. We will ask them questions to find out more about their role in the community. As speakers we will develop confidence in talking to others about what we would like to be when we are older and to imagine ourselves in a range of roles through our imaginative play as vets, police, teachers, firefighters and other people in the community.

Expressive arts and design

We will develop our own imaginative ideas through role play and stories as we explore what it would be like in a range of occupations. We will explore model making for different purposes.
