### **The Parents' Role in Homework**

DO	DON'T
<p>Listen to them read, or read to them everyday</p>	<p>Complete it for them</p>
<p>Ask them questions to expand their thinking, e.g. What....? When....? Why....? How....?</p>	<p>Make it all about expense (sometimes the cheapest ideas are the best)</p>
<p>Be willing to support their activity by listening to their ideas and suggesting ways forward</p>	
<p>Show them they can achieve</p>
