Reading	Reading to or sharing a book with an adult daily- please record this in your diary.

These skills are the building blocks for all areas of maths- recall should be fast and accurate. (We recommend that these should be practised little and often - the walk or drive to school or ten minutes several evenings a week would be ideal.)

Enrichment Homework

This half-term, our enrichment homework will be focussed on our Tomb Raider topic.
Your task is to complete one task from those listed below, (or if you want to, you can do more than one task)

<u>Cook like an Egyptian</u> Aish Baladi is an Egyptian flatbread. Find a recipe and make this treat for you and your family. Take photos, write reviews and be sure to show us and let us know how it went. Alternatively, if cake is more your thing, find a recipe for Basbousa, an Egyptian cake drenched in syrup. Make it and try it!	<u>Write like an Egyptian</u> In school we will be looking at Egyptian writing using hieroglyphics. Try making up your own hieroglyphic alphabet then use it to either write your name or a message for others to decode.
<u>Build like an Egyptian</u> The Ancient Egyptians were amazing architects. Try building your own pyramid or tomb, either indoors or outside, using whatever materials you would like.	<u>Play like an Egyptian</u> In Ancient Egypt, they liked to play games such as Senet, Mehen and Dogs and Jackals. Find out about one of these games and make your own version of it to play with your family and friends. You might need to write the rules out too so that no one cheats!
<u>Add like an Egyptian</u> Just like their writing, Egyptians used pictures to represent numbers. Find out what they were and use them to write sums for others to solve. Don't make them too tricky for us!	<u>Quiz like an Egyptian</u> Who doesn't love a quiz? Here is a very short quiz on Ancient Egypt but you could do better! Take the Ancient Egypt quiz - BBC Bitesize Make your own Egyptian quiz - you could write it, complete it on Google Slides or Forms or perhaps even make your own Kahoot!
<u>Worship like an Egyptian</u> The Ancient Egyptians worshipped many Gods and we will be learning more about these in school. They were often based on animals and had animal heads such as Anubis with the jackal head or Ra with the falcon head. Choose an animal and create your very own Egyptian God. What will they look like? What will they be holding and why? What will they be God of? Create a story for them too about how they became a God.
