Dear Parents and Carers of pupils in the Key Stage 2 Choir,

Christmas is always a busy time for the choir and this year is no exception! We have been asked to sing at three events as follows:

## **Light Up Maldon - Thursday, 28th November, The Town Hall (exact timing tbc)**

The Maldon Christmas Lights will be switched on at the Christmas Fayre in Maldon High Street on Thursday 28th November. All the local Primary Schools have been invited to perform at the Town Hall on Market Hill where there will also be a craft fayre. All Saints' will be the last choir to sing. The exact timing of our slot is still to be confirmed but my expectation is that we will start at around 7pm and will sing for around 20 minutes. Details of timing, including what time you should arrive, will be sent prior to the event but I need to gauge attendance now. Also, because of the crowded nature of this event, we ask that parents and carers stay in the building until the end of the performance.

## **Maldon Library - Saturday 7th December at 11am**

I am delighted to say we have been asked to join the PAMS (Plume Adult Music School) Choir and some pupils from the Plume Academy to sing at the Library. This is a low-key event which should bring some festive cheer to the library. The children are welcome to wear something christmassy if they like. We ask that children arrive just before 11am and parents and carers stay with them at the event.

## **The PTA Christmas Fayre - Friday 13<sup>th</sup> December immediately after school**

The choir will be singing to open the fayre again this year in the school hall. It really does kick things off on a high and hopefully will persuade people to spend lots of money in aid of the PTA! The children will then be free to enjoy the rest of their time at the event with their parents and carers.

**NOTE: As we still have these events to work towards, the KS2 Choir Club will carry on longer than the other clubs and will continue to take place on Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> December.**
