Key Skills Homework

Reading	Reading to an adult daily - please record this in your reading diary.
Spelling	Complete your weekly spelling assignments on Spelling shed. Aim to do this at least 3x per week.
Maths	Work on key mathematical skills on Top Marks games; tables, bonds, halving, doubling. These skills are the building blocks for all areas of maths- recall should be fast and accurate. (We recommend that these should be practised little and often - the walk or drive to school or ten minutes several evenings a week would be ideal.)

Enrichment Homework

**This half-term, our enrichment homework will be focussed on our Top Gear topic.
Your task is to complete one, or if you want, as many of the tasks set for you.**

Design the Transport of the Future How will we all be getting around in 50 years time? A 100 years time? Use your imagination & develop your creativity as you design a mode of transport for the future. You can present your ideas in whichever way you prefer; a drawing, a painting, a model, a written description, a Google Slides - the choice is yours.	Animal Power Investigate how animals have been or are still used for transport. e.g. Huskies, horses, donkeys, camels. Present your work in an interesting way.
Become a Historian In class, we have learnt about the history of cars. Explore the history of another mode of transport, finding pictures and information of how it has progressed through time. Present your findings as a timeline so that others can see the changes that have happened.	Map Making Think about a journey you often make. Can you draw a simple map showing some of the things you see on the way? You could create a key & use simple pictures to represent the things you see. Could you include a grid on your map too so that we can use grid references to locate things. Why not try to make your map 3D.
Game Playing Can you design a transport based racing game? Your board could be a race track, your counters could be vehicles. Use your imagination to invent your own amazing game.	Car Logos Can you find out about the different makes of cars and their logos? Perhaps you would like to make it into a matching game, create a powerpoint or choose a different way to present your findings.

Please complete the enrichment homework and bring it into school on **Tuesday 5th November** where it will be displayed in the hall as part of open afternoon.

The work should be:

- Well presented, showing care and thought.	- Creative.
- A mixture of things that they have learnt at home and things they have learnt at school.	- Their own work - they might need help but they should not let their grown-ups do it for them.
