<p>PE</p> <p>Have a go at completing the Maldon Junior Park run at the Prom on a Sunday morning. Make a certificate with a photo or picture telling us about your experience.</p>	<p>Computing</p> <p>Take photographs of "Autumn signs" and make an Autumnal photo collage with your pictures.</p>	<p>Art/ History</p> <p>Maldon is famous for its river and the Thames Barges that can be found on the quayside. What can you find out about the barges? Think of an interesting way to present your information. Perhaps you could make a model or complete a piece of artwork depicting a Thames Barge.</p>
<p>Cooking</p> <p>Design and make some Mr Men biscuits.</p>	<p>Science and Nature</p> <p>Take a walk around the Prom Park. Look for signs that Summer is changing into Autumn.</p> <p>Make a collection of things that show you that it is Autumn & present them in an interesting way.</p>	<p>Geography</p> <p>Draw a map of the Prom showing your favourite places in the park. Perhaps you can add a key to your map too?</p>
