Pupils do not need new or expensive clothes. valuables must not be brought to Hilltop

Packed Lunch

The first meal provided by Hilltop will be an evening meal. Therefore, as we are due to arrive at 11:00am, your child will need a packed lunch for the first day and a named water bottle to use on subsequent days.

Bedding

Pillows will be provided. Your child will need to bring either a sleeping bag and a pillowcase **OR** a duvet, pillowcase and a bottom sheet. This should be packed into a black bag and clearly named. Please also pack a spare named black bag for the return journey.

Personal Kit - IMPORTANT NO VALUABLES

Waterproof jacket and trousers

Outdoor trainers

Wellington Boots

Indoor shoes or slippers (not slipper socks)

3 sets of old clothes (minimum) - jeans/shorts/tracksuit bottoms/t-shirts/sweatshirts are ideal **NO VEST TOPS**

Swimming kit (goggles can be included if worn but a hat is not required - costumes should be a full swimsuit or trunks, no bikinis or two pieces)

Underwear and socks

Hair bands if needed

Shorts

Personal washing items (in a named toilet bag)

Towel

Watch

Named water bottle

Stamps

Insect repellent

Antihistamine cream for bites (which children can keep in their bags and apply themselves)

Sun cream

Sunhat

A named bin bag for wet/dirty clothes and boots/trainers

Tuckshop money (up to £10.00 maximum)

NO ELECTRONICS - This includes mobile phones/tablets/MP3 players/digital cameras
