The largest city in Great Britain is London. Listen to the story 'Katie in London' https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=lmrNxvC9bb4 Change the name of the story to include your name instead and write your own version of the story with places that you visit. Can you find out about one famous landmark in London that interests you? Perhaps the Tower of London, Buckingham Palace or Big Ben. Create a poster or leaflet advertising the landmark as a place to visit. Paddington Bear visits many landmarks in his books too. Write about a place in Britain you have visited. What was there? Why did you like it so much? British Weather! Maybe you would like to film yourself presenting the forecast! Choose one or two animals to write about. Try writing an acrostic poem about Britain. Use the letters in Britain as the start of each new line in your poem and try to use lots of description to describe how great it is! Can you make a list of some great British authors and list their books. Can you sort the books into genres (funny/sad/adventure/factual)? Make a union jack flag, bunting or paper chains to celebrate VE Day. Find out about traditional British food (cottage pie, apple crumble) and recreate it in an imaginative way or help an adult at home to prepare dinner for you and your family. Learn about the famous British Artist Andy Goldsworthy. Make your own piece of art inspired by him. Make a bird feeder. Britain is lucky to have a health system as great as the NHS. Make a poster to promote our fantastic NHS.	Britain has many fantastic cities. Look at a map of Britain. Can you locate the names of some cities? Where in Britain are they? Which country? North or South? Do you know what our national flag looks like? It is sometimes called the Union Jack. Can you find out why it looks the way it does? Learn about British birds. LINK What birds can you see out of your window? Keep a record for the week of the different birds you see. LINK Which trees are native to Britain? On your walk record the types of trees you see, maybe collect a leaf from each and discuss how they are similar/different. The following identification sheet may be helpful when naming the trees you see. LINK You could use the leaves you find to make your Andy Goldworthy inspired picture. The British Royal Family is led by Queen Elizabeth II. Who else is a member of the Royal family? Can you draw a family tree for the Royal family? Find out about capitals cities in the UK: LINK Can you find out about Loch Ness? Can you draw what it might look like? Can you draw and name some landmarks in our capital cities? Can you name the countries in the UK? Can you draw a map of the UK and label it? Where can you find zoos in Britain?
