What days out do you enjoy during the summer holidays? It could be a day at the zoo or farm, or a walk to the park or just visiting friends and family. Can you write about what your day might look like. I used to send postcards when I was on holiday. Maybe you could design and write a postcard to your year 6 buddy before they leave for their new school. And don't forget to sign up for the Summer Reading Challenge, as it's online, this year! http://www.sillysquad.org.uk/	Do you have a selection of jugs and containers to explore capacity using water (or sand if you're lucky enough to have some). Could you use different shapes and construction materials to make a 'sandcastle'? What shapes have you used? How high have you made your castle? Draw an ice cream cone. Add a scoop of ice cream on top, maybe in pink for strawberry. Now add another scoop - maybe green for mint. What would your next flavour be? Can you repeat this pattern? How many scoops of ice cream will your ice cream cone hold? (See sheet below for example) Year 6 normally finish their time at All Saints' walking through an arch made by the arms of everyone at the school. Could you create your own arch to share with them? What resources could you use? Will it be 2D or 3D? Can you make your own sun catcher by collecting flower petals and sticking these onto sticky back plastic or sellotape. Could you put them in a frame and hang it outside or in the window?

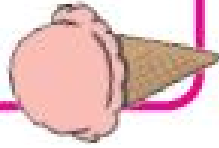
It's nearly the summer holidays! Can you have an end of term party to celebrate how wonderful you have been?

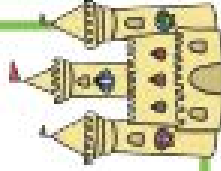

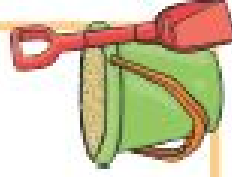

Seaside In A Bottle

Supplies

- Plastic water bottle
- Sand
- Assortment of shells
- Pebbles
- Funnel
- Blue food colouring
- Washing up liquid



- Card
- Fine line pen
- Ribbon or string
- Hole punch



- 1 Using a funnel, pour sand into the plastic bottle until it is $\frac{1}{4}$ full.



- 2 Now choose objects to make your seaside scene! We used shells and pebbles.



- 3 Add a few drops of blue food colouring and washing up liquid to the water.



- 4 Top the bottle up with water, again using the funnel to pour.



- 5 Screw the lid tightly onto the bottle. Now place it on its side and allow the contents to settle. You should end up with your very own seaside scene!



- 6 Now make a tag for your bottle. Using scissors, cut out a small rectangular shape from the card. Then use a hole punch to make a hole at one end. We stained ours with tea to make it look old.



- 7 Using a fine line pen, write a message such as 'My Seaside in a bottle' onto the tag.



- 8 Thread a length of ribbon or wool round the neck of the bottle and tie the tag on to it.
