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| <p>Apparently there are 297 species of butterfly that come from Madagascar (a few are pictured below)</p> <p>Could you practise your colouring mixing skills and just use red, blue and yellow to create some other colours or could you draw or paint a beautiful butterfly, and give it a special name?</p> <p>Can you design your own island? What sort of things would you like on your island? Who else would love there? What animals would live on your island? Can you draw it or build it?</p> <p><b>Can you paint, draw or create your favourite character from the film Madagascar?</b></p> <p>Can you sing the song, Down in the Jungle and do the actions?<br/> <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=dFigIHPwU">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=dFigIHPwU</a></p> <p>On some islands it doesn't rain very often and people make up songs and dances to make it rain. There is a musical instrument called a rainmaker that you could make and use it to do a raindance.<br/> <a href="https://climatekids.nasa.gov/rainstick/">https://climatekids.nasa.gov/rainstick/</a></p> | <p>What is an island? Do you know any islands?<br/> What is a rainforest? Do you know anything about them?<br/> What is the same and what is different about the island Madagascar compared to home.<br/> Use the film to help you, or maybe you could look at some photos on Google.</p> <p>Can you look at the different plants around where you live?<br/> Do they look like the plants that come from Madagascar? (scroll down for some examples) Talk to your grown up about the colours and the shapes. Can you draw some of the flowers from your garden or around where you live?</p> <p><b>Lots of frogs live in Madagascar. 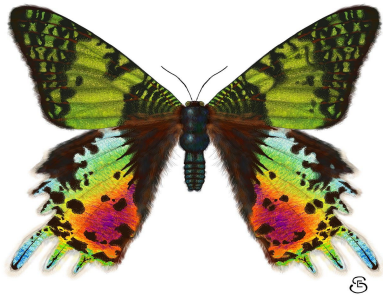
