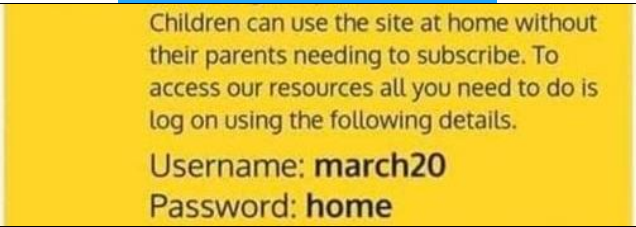
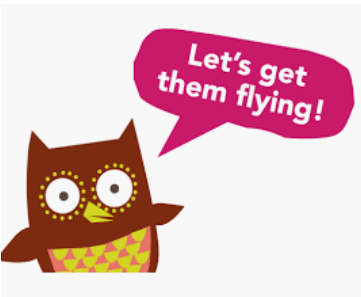
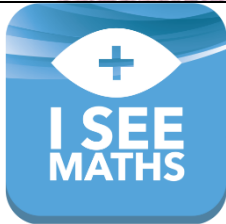


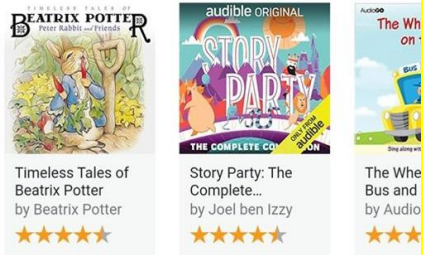
Some Useful Home Learning Links

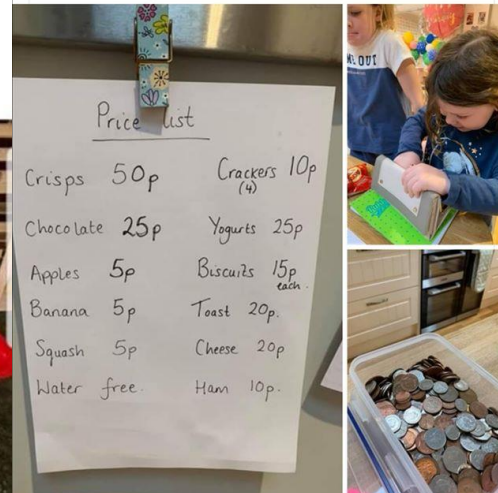
Ideas to help:

An idea for the kids

Our children are living through history right now. So why not get them to make a time capsule.

Talk about what they would like to be when they grow up and 5 things they want to do when they are an adult.
