Communication and Language

We will learn to listen to others and respond to them appropriately. We will listen and respond to a variety of familiar stories and relate them to our own experiences. We will learn social phrases to communicate our needs.

Personal, Social and Emotional

We will learn to become more independent in our new school environment and with our new routines. We will get to know our new friends and adults in the classroom. We will explore the dynamics of our families. We will start exploring feelings using The Big 3 and Me and The Zones of Regulation. We will find out about and start to build a growth mindset.

Physical Development

We will explore our new environment and learn to consider safety aspects in a range of activities. This will include PE lessons where we will use a variety of equipment through gymnastics. We will explore a range of activities to promote fine motor skills and begin to hold a pencil correctly when making marks or following patterns..

Expressive Arts and Design

We will recount narratives and stories through role play, using different props to develop our understanding and our place within our world. We will sing songs and play musical instruments and learn simple musical notation in our discrete music lessons. We will begin to develop our creative thinking through mark making, painting and sticking in our creative areas.

Understanding the World

We will explore our own family history by discussing who is in our family and how we have changed. We will discover where we are all from and discuss the places we live. We will look at the changes in the natural world focusing on the season of Autumn. We will explore why God is important to Christians.

Mathematics

We will start our maths journey using White Rose Maths. We will focus on matching, sorting/comparing, talk about measures and patterns and It's me 1,2,3. We will take part in hands-on maths activities using concrete resources.

Literacy

We will develop our love of books, demonstrating how to handle books and how to follow text. We will begin phonic sessions, in which we will learn letter sounds using Phonics Shed. Through our topic we will have a range of opportunities to write and make marks to communicate meaning. We will start by using secret symbols to mark make with meaning in all areas of our classroom environment.
