We will explore the world using google maps and the school Library.

Communication and Language

We will continue to develop our listening and responding skills to recall information, using full sentences. We will practice taking turns to talk in groups and 1:1 conversations encouraging responses with comments and ideas, for example we will compare stories and information books about the world.

Personal, Social and Emotional

We will continue 'The Big 3 and Me' by focusing on Truth;Doing, developing our self-awareness skills. We will share our thoughts and feelings exploring the perspective of others. We will continue to build our growth mindset acknowledging that we can do hard things.

Physical Development

In PE we will learn skills and techniques in gymnastics exploring different ways to move and balance. We will take part in regular handwriting lessons where we will develop our fine motor skills to be able to form letters using the correct formation. We will use a range of tools and equipment in independent learning, such as, scissors, rolling pins, knives and cutters.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will use our imaginations to make up our own stories and world adventures. We will design and make rockets and other travelling equipment, exploring a range of tools and techniques as we learn more about shaping, assembling and joining the Materials. In music we will sing songs from other cultures and around the world. We will also explore instruments from other cultures.

Understanding the World

We will explore the natural world focusing on different countries and habitats using videos, maps and non-fiction texts. We will look at the similarities and differences to where we live. We will explore how to care for our world and local environment and what happens when we don't. Through RE we will explore Being Special and where we belong.

Mathematics

We will continue our maths journey using White Rose maths covering the topics; Alive in 5, Mass and Capacity and Growing 6, 7, 8. The lessons will consist on hands on activities and a workbook task.

Literacy

In phonics we will build on our phonic knowledge by continuing to work through Chapter 2 sounds and words. We will write short phrases or sentences using VC and CVC words relating to our topic. Children will read in groups and will be encouraged to read at home. We will also explore the alphabetic order and find out about vowels and consonants. A range of writing and reading activities using fiction and non-fiction are available throughout the topic.
