We will write our own stories and share them with other classes in school.

Communication and Language

We will use stories to extend our vocabulary and imagination as we describe characters, settings and recreate roles and experiences within our play and our own stories. We will begin to ask questions and make relevant comments about the stories we read.



Personal, Social and Emotional

We will continue 'The Big 3 and Me' by focusing on Truth; Doing, developing our self-awareness skills. We will consider why we need to follow rules, what it feels like when we try to do things ourselves for the first time, how we can make choices that help us feel good about ourselves and how we help the people around us.

Physical Development

We will continue to develop different ways of negotiating space and moving safely, developing our balance and coordination. We will develop our team work skills as we work with a partner and play team games through multi skills lessons. We will continue to take part in handwriting lessons to ensure correct letter formation.

Understanding the World

We will look closely at similarities, differences, patterns and changes highlighted within different stories and relate them to our own lives and the world around us. We will explore why Easter is special to Christians. We will learn about different types of technology and how to keep safe whilst using them. We will look at the changes in the natural world focusing on the season of Spring.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will sing songs related to the stories we read. We will focus on singing with more accurate pitching. We will explore colour mixing and creating patterns using different marks. We will use illustrators to inspire our art.

Mathematics

We will continue our maths journey using White Rose Maths. We will focus on Length height and time, building 9 and 10 and explore 3D shapes. We will take part in hands-on maths activities using concrete resources.

Literacy

We will begin to learn new letter sounds from Phonics Shed Chapter Three. We will listen to and read stories by the same author. We will learn about traditional tales and write our own stories applying our phonics skills by writing sentences using VC, CVC and CVCC words.
