We will visit the Moot Hall to enhance our learning and increase our knowledge of the local area.

We are going to become mini architects planning, designing and modelling how to make different megastructures such as a skyscraper and bridge.

Geography

We will look at the different continents of the world and the various types of megastructures situated within them. Additionally, we will take a trip to The Moot Hall and explore a local megastructure too.

English

We will explore non-chronological reports based on megastructures locally as well as from different continents around the world. We will also write a narrative recount based on the clip 'Home Sweet Home'.

Science

We will explore the different properties of rocks we would use to build specific megastructures. We will also investigate the formation of rocks and soils. We will learn how fossils are formed.
