

## Making memories to build memory through:

We will be visiting Leeches Garden to inspire our writing. We will also visit Thorndon Park to take part in a range of activities in nature including geocaching and natural art.

We will use the natural world & famous artists to inspire our own natural artwork in our local environment.

### Art

We will develop our artistic skills using observational drawings and mark making skills by collecting natural materials and using them as a palette. We will explore a range of natural sculpture materials then design and create our own, inspired by the work of land artists Richard Shilling & Andy Goldsworthy. We will also make our own recycled paper.

### English

We will write magical poems inspired by nature. We will create leaflets for other schools that might want to visit Thorndon Park. Finally we will imagine what it would be like to be shrunk to a tiny size & we will write exciting narratives to tell these stories.

### Computing

We will learn to use Google sheets & put weather data into charts and then convert this data into graphs. We will then act as meteorologists, filming and presenting our own weather reports using Sheets & Slides.

### RE

### French

We will build numbers up to 60 and learn about different types of food shops in France as well as how to ask for what we would like when shopping.

### Geography

Using "Old Enough to Save the Planet" we will learn about the different environmental challenges around the world:

Deforestation  
Endangered species.  
Protecting bees.  
Littering.  
Traffic pollution.  
Food waste.



### Science

We will learn about the parts of a plant by dissecting plants, flowers and fruits and what plants need in order to grow by growing our own in the allotment. We will also find out about the life cycle of a plant. We will recreate the greenhouse effect with glass jars to recognise the impact of changing environments.

### Music

We will use birdsong as the focus for our learning about music. We will listen and respond to music featuring birds and learn how to trill on the recorder.

### PSHE

We will look at the similarities and differences between boys and girls, including naming body parts. We will study how our bodies change and develop as we grow.
