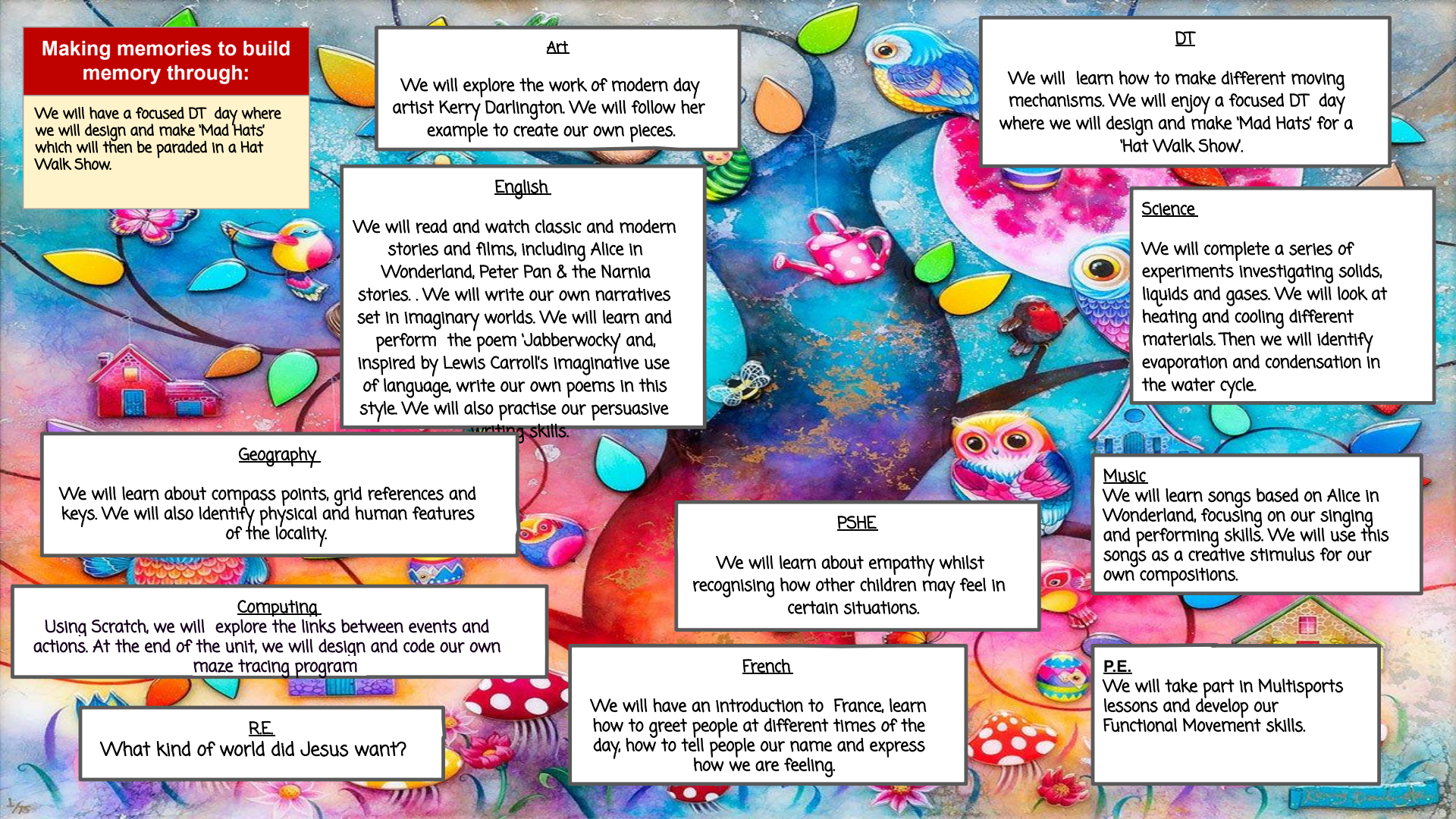




Making memories to build memory through:

We will have a focused DT day where we will design and make 'Mad Hats' which will then be paraded in a Hat Walk Show.

Art

We will explore the work of modern day artist Kerry Darlington. We will follow her example to create our own pieces.

English

We will read and watch classic and modern stories and films, including Alice in Wonderland, Peter Pan & the Narnia stories. We will write our own narratives set in imaginary worlds. We will learn and perform the poem 'Jabberwocky' and, inspired by Lewis Carroll's imaginative use of language, write our own poems in this style. We will also practise our persuasive writing skills.

Geography

We will learn about compass points, grid references and keys. We will also identify physical and human features of the locality.

Computing

Using Scratch, we will explore the links between events and actions. At the end of the unit, we will design and code our own maze tracing program

RE

DT

We will learn how to make different moving mechanisms. We will enjoy a focused DT day where we will design and make 'Mad Hats' for a 'Hat Walk Show'.

Science

We will complete a series of experiments investigating solids, liquids and gases. We will look at heating and cooling different materials. Then we will identify evaporation and condensation in the water cycle.

PSHE

We will learn about empathy whilst recognising how other children may feel in certain situations.

French

We will have an introduction to France, learn how to greet people at different times of the day, how to tell people our name and express how we are feeling.

Music

We will learn songs based on Alice in Wonderland, focusing on our singing and performing skills. We will use this songs as a creative stimulus for our own compositions.
