Art & DT

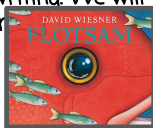
We will look at underwater creatures, shells, seaweed & coral & experiment with sketching these forms. Next we will apply these forms to a wax resist picture.

After exploring under the sea worlds we will design & make a model aquarium.

English

We will use Blue Planet documentaries as inspiration for our information texts about the five layers of the ocean.

We will use Flotsam as a basis for our descriptive & diary writing. We will write adventure stories linked to natural disasters eg tsunamis, flooding.



French

We will learn about French money, and some vocabulary relating to different foods and food shops. Using this knowledge, we will learn to: order food in a cafe; say if we like something or not; and finally role-play a restaurant scene.

Computing

We will explore the concept of repetition in programming using the Scratch.

PE

We will develop our Athletic skills and our Striking & Fielding skills.

Geography

Using atlases, we will identify oceans and seas. We will focus on each of the major oceans individually & learn about their individual characteristics.

Science

We will learn about marine animals and use classification keys to group and identify them including vertebrates and invertebrates. We will also look at food chains and identify producers, predators and prey.

PSHE

We will consider spending decisions; learn about how to create a budget; recognise that money affects how we feel and how we feel when money is lost.
