Art

We will be creating digital compositions by taking 'small world' photos of a dinosaur scene. We will then combine this with our computing skills to photograph ourselves in front of the green screen in order to add ourselves to the dinosaur image. As we move through the topic, we will be travelling through time to insert ourselves into different scenes.

English

We will explore the theories on how the dinosaurs became extinct and write non-chronological reports explaining these. We will also look at the life of Cleopatra and write biographies to answer the question: "Was Cleopatra a good leader?"

History

We will travel through time looking at periods of history such as the age of the dinosaurs and The Early Islamic Civilisation. We will look at other historical events before looking to the future.
