

Forest School / Outdoor learning from home wk 5 EYFS **Space**

- Landart space rocket - use sticks and leaves to make a picture of a rocket.
- Build a den / rocket inside or outside using blankets and chairs and use your imagination to fly away somewhere.
- Do a quiet sit spot and just listen in the garden for 5 minutes. Pretend you are on a different planet and imagine the noises you hear are aliens.
- Using mud or play dough see if you can make spheres (balls) as planets. Then you can add leaves and sticks to the outside to show trees or other things on the planet. You could add moss for grass.
- If you have some chalk see if you can draw the solar system on a patio or pavement.
- Use mud or playdough to make alien mud monsters using natural things to add detail
- Then you can make a habitat for your alien in a tray or in a bed in the garden using natural things. Are there craters and mountains on your planet?
- Dance around the garden like there is no gravity. If you have a trampoline practice your space walk.

I hope you have been practicing your dressing and undressing and getting good at putting on your socks, boots and gloves and doing up the zip on your coats. Just imagine how tricky it would be to get dressed in a space suit.
