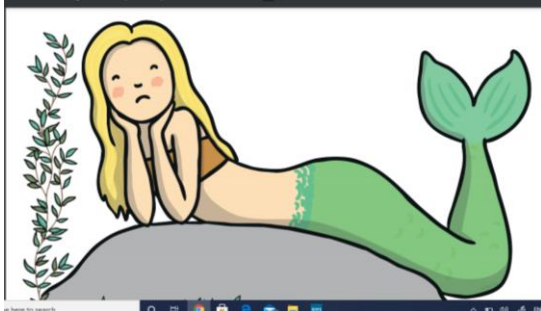


EYFS Menu of Activities Week Beginning 18.1.21 Under the Sea
