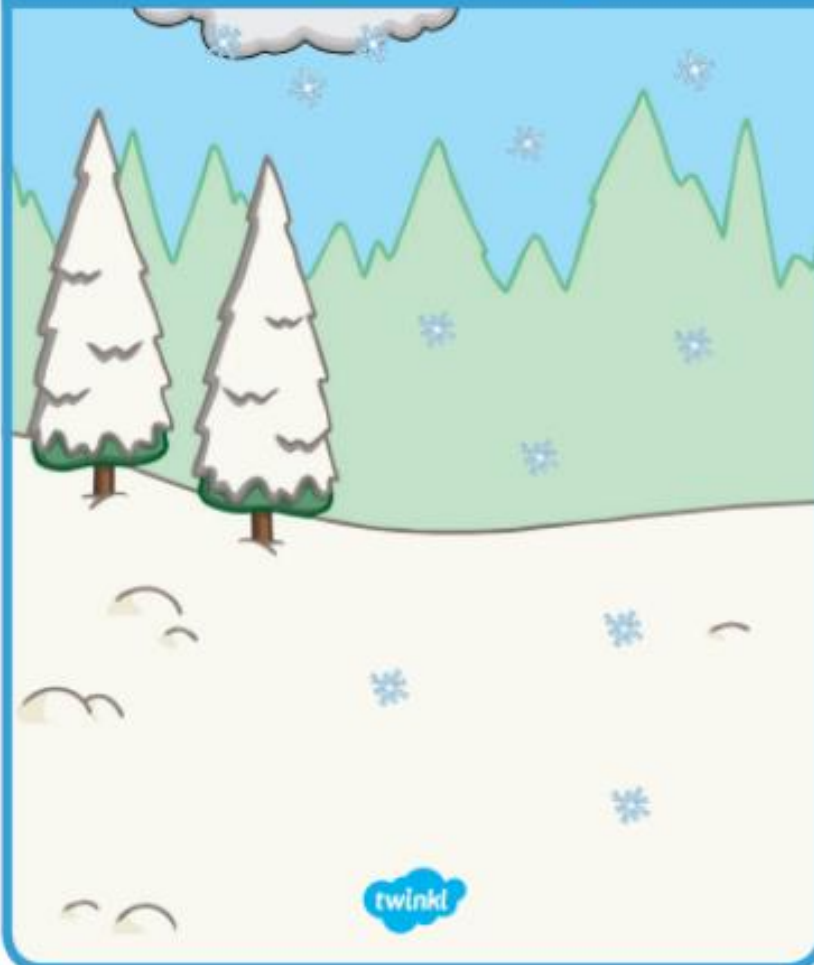
Go for a walk with a grown-up and talk about what changes happen in winter time. Use a camera to capture some lovely winter photographs. Investigate freezing and melting by making some ice cubes. Discuss how the water changes and record how long it takes them to melt. (powerpoint on school website in EYFS tab)	Become a birdwatcher and see if you can spot any birds in your garden or on your walk. Draw a picture of the birds that you see. Create a winter picture or winter collage. Design your own hat scarf and glove set. (template is own tapestry documents if you would like it)

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Make a Snowflake

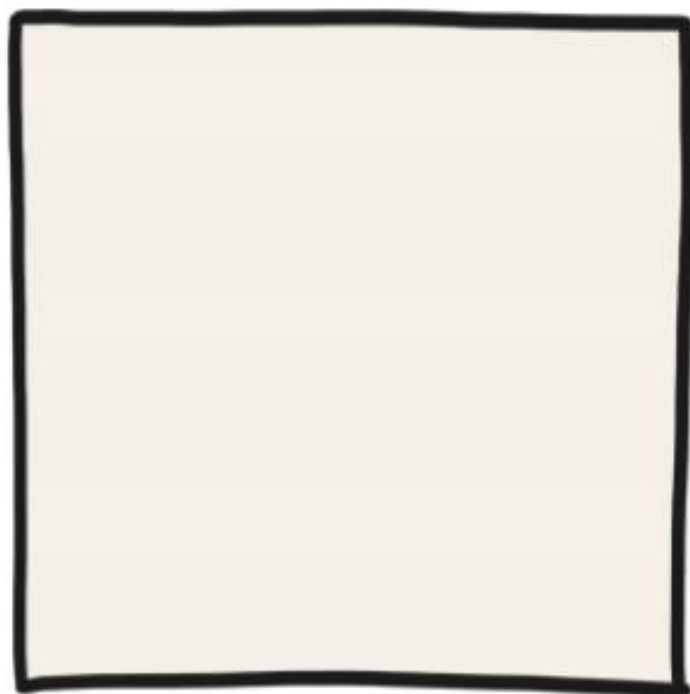
You will need:

- Scissors



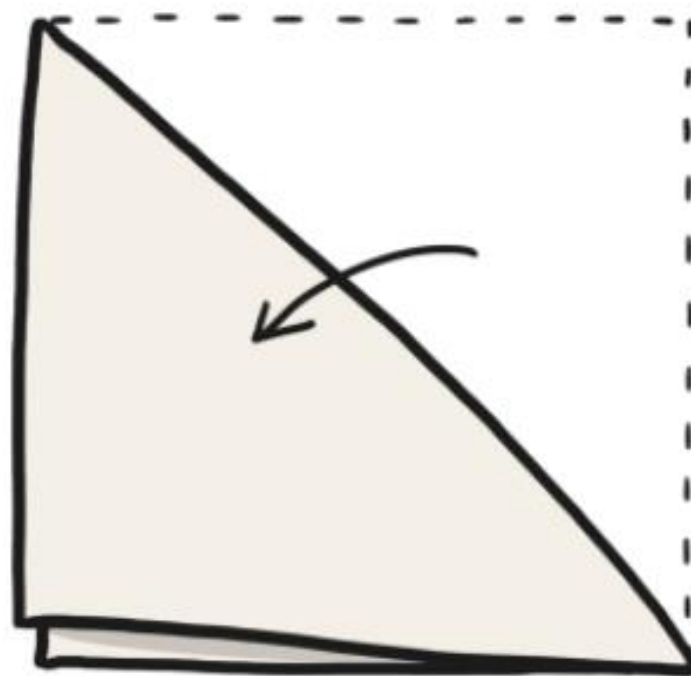
Make a Snowflake

1. Start with a square piece of paper.



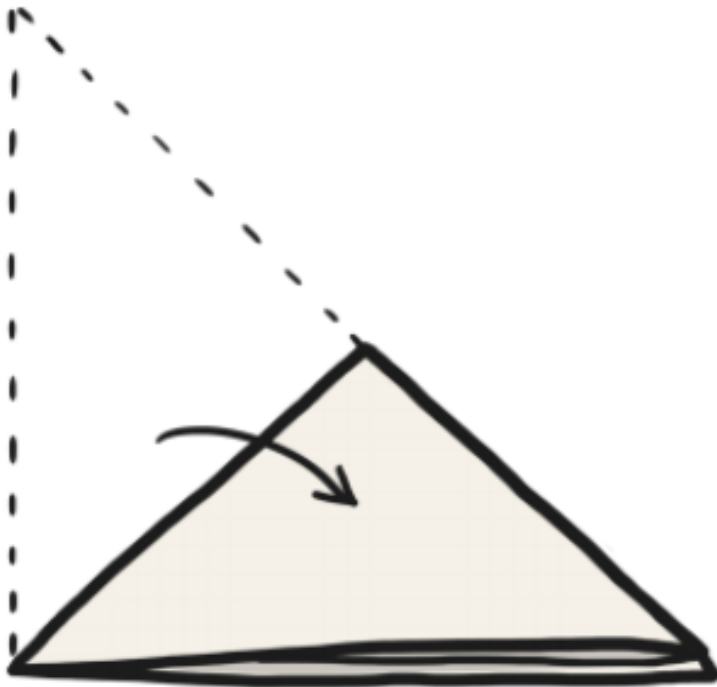
Make a Snowflake

2. Fold the paper in half to make a triangle.



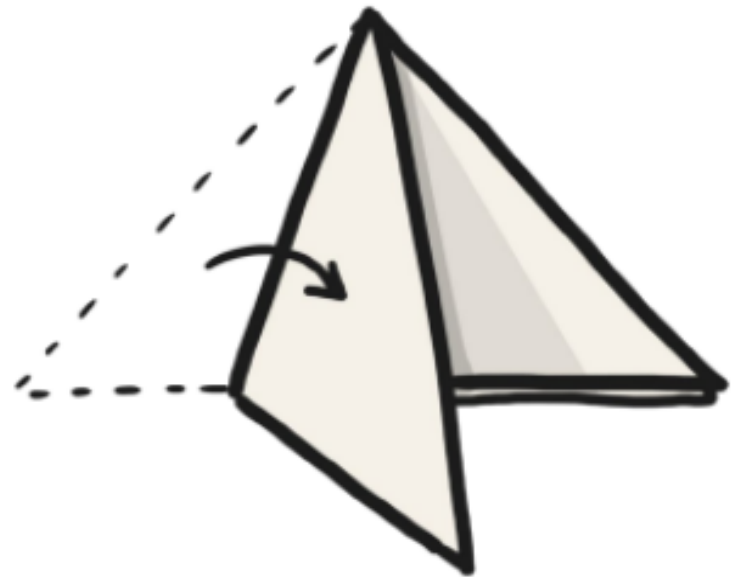
Make a Snowflake

3. Fold the paper in half again.



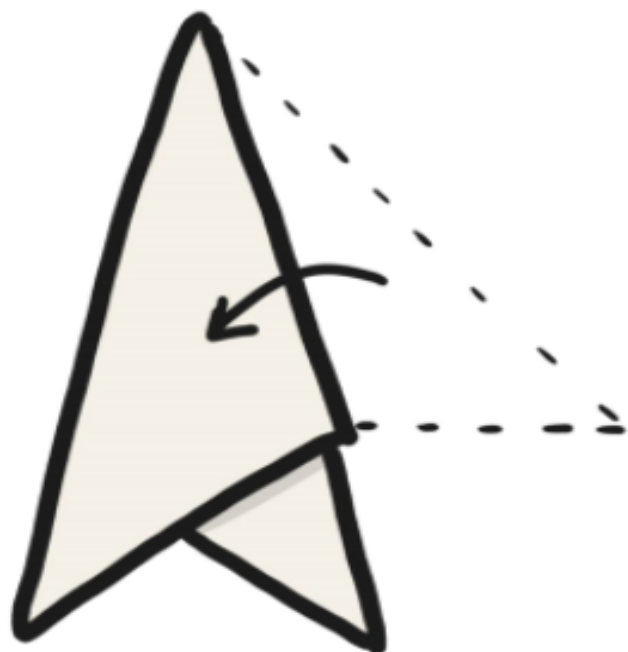
Make a Snowflake

4. Make a fold a third of the way across the triangle.



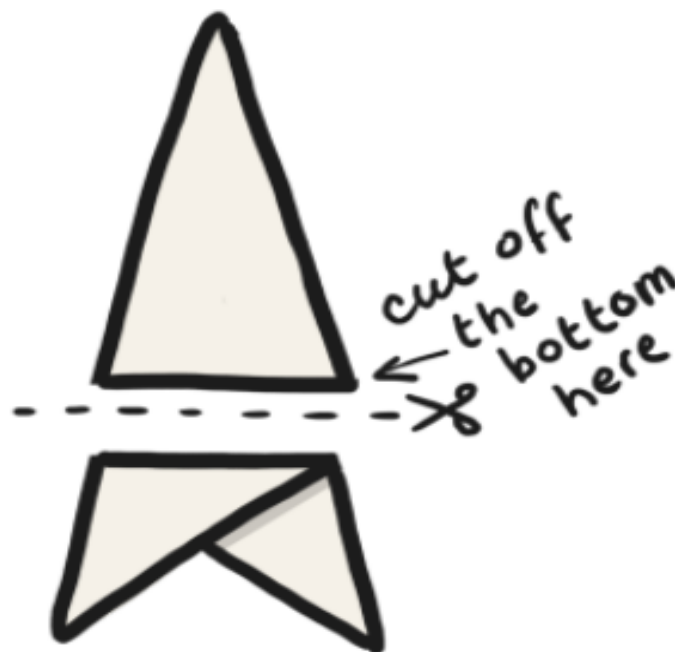
Make a Snowflake

5. Fold the other side over to create an arrowhead shape.

6. Cut off the bottom to make a triangle.
