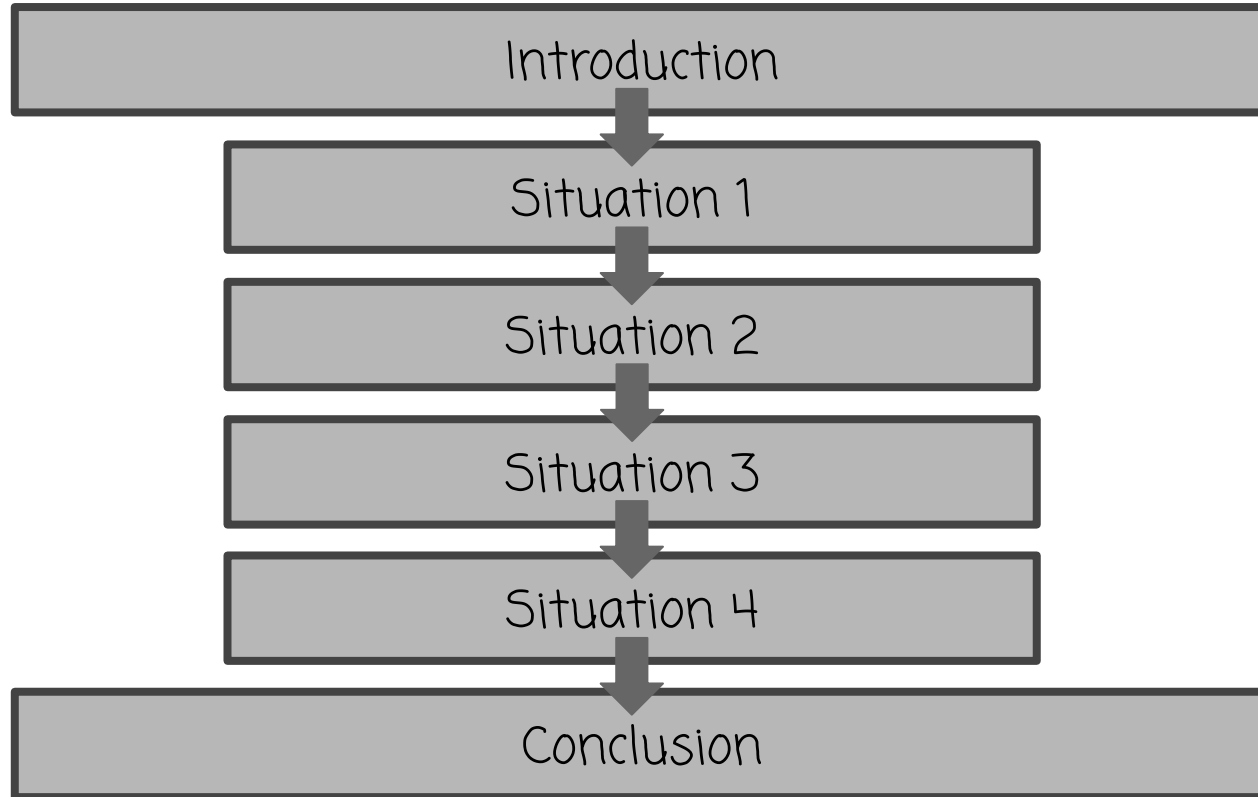

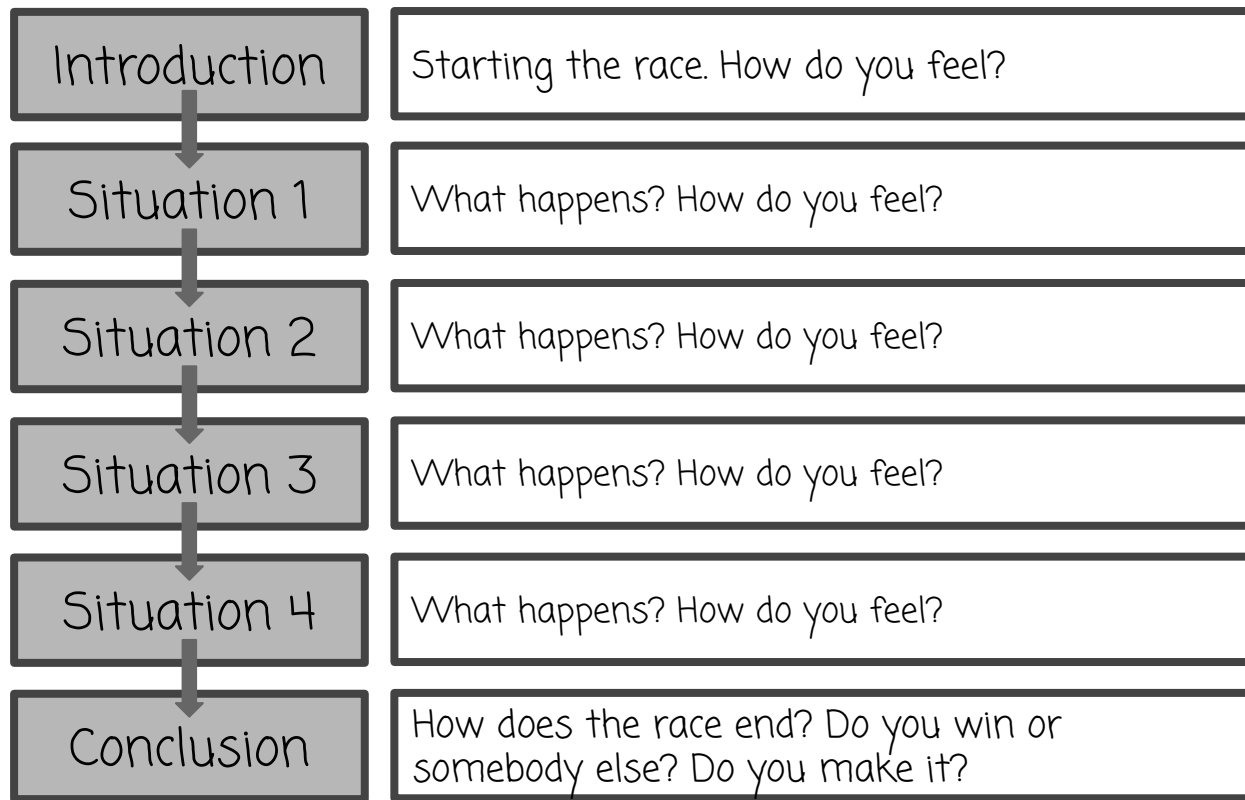

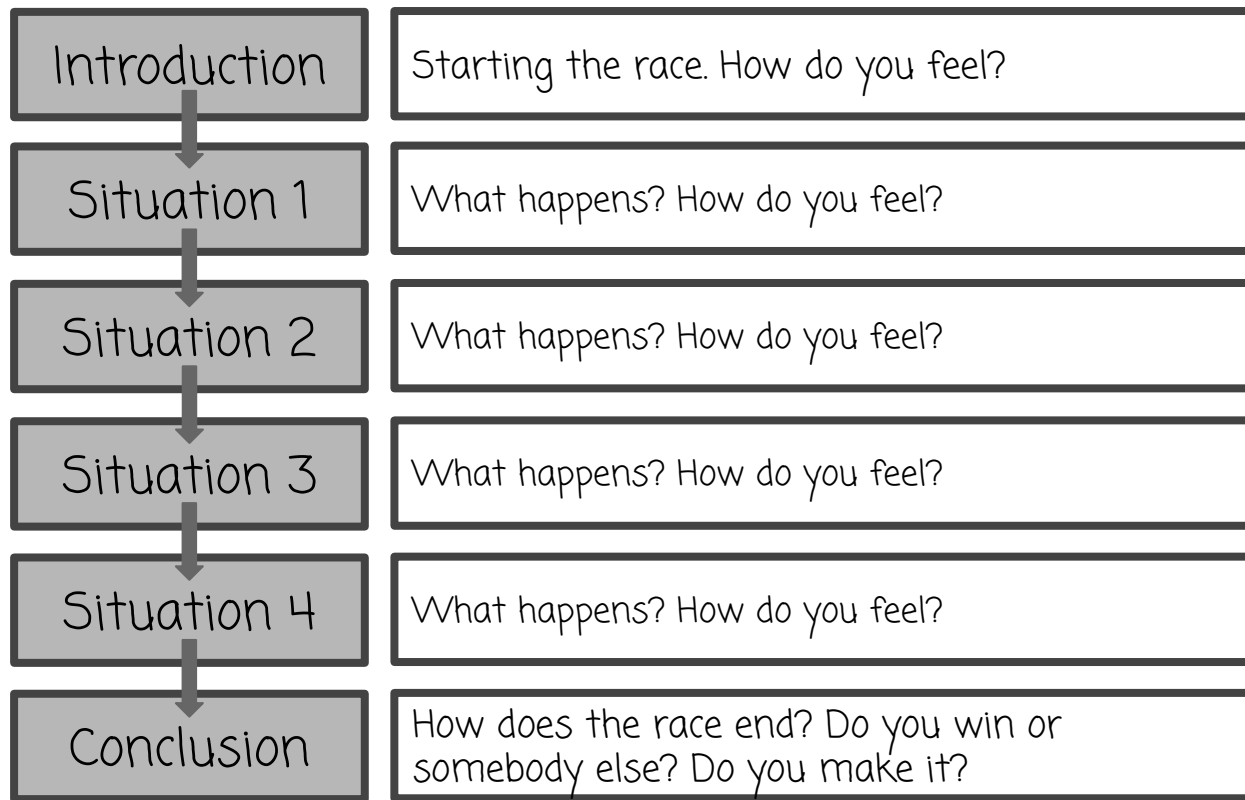
5, 4, 3, 2, 1 AND WE ARE OFF! Emerald green flags waved in the air and the challenge had commenced.

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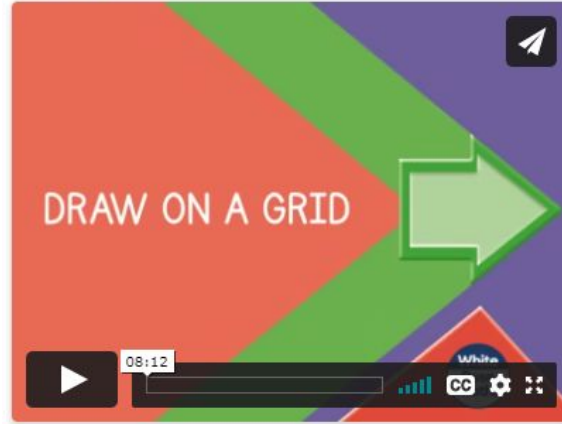
Maths Lesson - Draw on a Grid

B (2, 3)

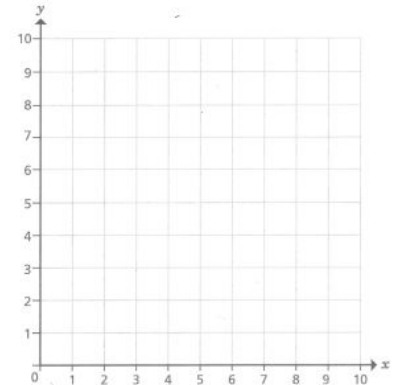
C (6, 4)
