Dear Parents and Carers,

Re: EYFS trip to Boydells Farm, Wednesday 3rd June 2026

On **Wednesday 3rd June 2026** the EYFS team have organised an exciting trip for the Ducklings and Cygnets children to visit Boydells Dairy Farm in Braintree. The children will be taken by coach directly from School at 9.00am and returned at the end of the school day by 3.15pm.

We ask that children are in school to be registered by 8.45am at the very latest so that we are able to depart from Highlands Drive promptly. At the end of the day you will collect your child from their usual classroom at 3.15pm as normal.

- **Clothing/footwear:**

In order to easily identify our pupils, they must wear their school jumper/cardigan. However, as they will be taking part in various outdoor activities during the day they may wear comfortable trousers or shorts and wellie boots. They will also need a waterproof coat and sunhat. Please also ensure your child has already had sunscreen applied for the day.

- **Lunch/Snacks:**

Please send your child with a packed lunch (do not include fizzy drinks) and a named refillable water bottle. **If you would like the school to provide a packed lunch for your child, please either complete the attached form and hand it to the office or email your selection by reply to this email by Monday 22nd May** at the latest. The children may also bring a healthy snack with them to eat in the afternoon as we will have some free time before we travel home.

We ask that children do not bring anything valuable such as toys or money - they will not be permitted to eat sweets on the coach.

- **Payment:**

In order for your child to attend this activity **you must give permission via the School Gateway App**. The total cost of this trip will be £16.50 per child to cover the cost of transport and entry fee to Boydells Farm.

In line with the Education Reform Act of 1988 (Section 118 (2), this amount can only be asked for as a voluntary donation and will not prejudice any child's attendance. However, I must stress that if enough donations are not received then the activities will have to be cancelled. The school does not receive funding for activities of this nature. If parents are unable to make any voluntary contribution because of financial difficulties, please discuss this with Mrs Hewer. If your child is unable to attend an activity due to illness, then the cost of the activity will be reimbursed.

- **Medical:**

If your child requires travel sickness tablets please administer them before school in the morning and give the ones for the return journey to the class teacher in a named envelope with full instructions written on the front.
