



Menu of Activities - Week Beginning 22.02.21

Whilst you are learning at home, every day you will have recorded English and Maths lessons from your KS2 teachers. In school, we also learn lots of other different subjects! Each week we will post a menu of activities that link to our topic. Across the week, you can select which of these activities that you would like to do, perhaps in the afternoons, but make sure that you do your Maths and English lessons too.

Subject	Activity
Science	This week we have another exciting experiment for you. Follow and complete the lesson by watching Miss Cooch in her video which you can find HERE or in section on the website for Monday 22nd February's lessons. You will need to use this recording sheet to help with the experiment, download it HERE or from the website.
Art and DT	In DT this week, we are looking at Ancient Egyptian Death Masks. Your task will be to design a death mask for a pharaoh, which we will then go on to make and construct next time. Use this PowerPoint in the folder and use this template to help you with your design.
RE	The story of Moses so far - born a Hebrew- put in basket in river- saved and brought up by Egyptian Princess - finds out he is a Hebrew - kills a slave master - runs away to desert- gets married and becomes a shepherd - God appears as burning bush and tells Moses he must return to Egypt to save the Hebrews and that God will help him. Moses and Aaron (his brother) went to see the Pharaoh. Watch the clip about the 9 plagues. The First Nine Plagues of Egypt Think how awful it would have been for the Egyptians (the Hebrews were not afflicted by them in the same way) Remember Moses asked the Pharaoh after each plague to let the Hebrews go. Each time he said no. TASKS: 1. Learn the song using the tune Ten Little Indians - Karaoke Here are the words: Ten Plagues Of Egypt song words 2. Complete the sheet writing or illustrations. The first 9 plagues of Egypt 3. Jews and Christians believe these were miracles from God. What do you think? Could you explain the plagues in any other way?
Computing	This half term we are going to be exploring google docs, google slides and making sure we understand everything there is to do on each of those programmes. For our first week we will be studying google docs. You have all used Google Docs before in school but we want you to explore it further this week, do you know how to use all of the tools? Go onto Google Classroom, find the document that we have put on there for you and edit the text by completing the challenges below. We would like you to try to complete these challenges: - Change the font - Change the size - Change the colour of the writing - Make the title bold - Make the title underlined - Insert a relevant image - Resize that image so that it fits to scale on the page

History and Geography	This week's History lesson is about the mummification process and the Opening of the Mouth Ceremony. Two very important parts of the burial process of Pharaohs and very important Ancient Egyptians that would preserve them for the afterlife so that they may survive for eternity. Watch this CLIP, which explains about the mummification process in detail and how important the canopic jars are in this process. Think about the different organs which are put into each jar (you can use the clip again to go back and help you sort the organs). Finally think about the Opening of the Mouth ceremony (gold spoon and weighing of the heart) and remember what you have seen as you will need it to help you record this information on the worksheet which you can find HERE.
PE	If you have not seen Mr Brown's post on FB about Kane and the coaches that come into our school then you might not know that they have made lots of video tutorials for many of the PE skills we learn in school.
