

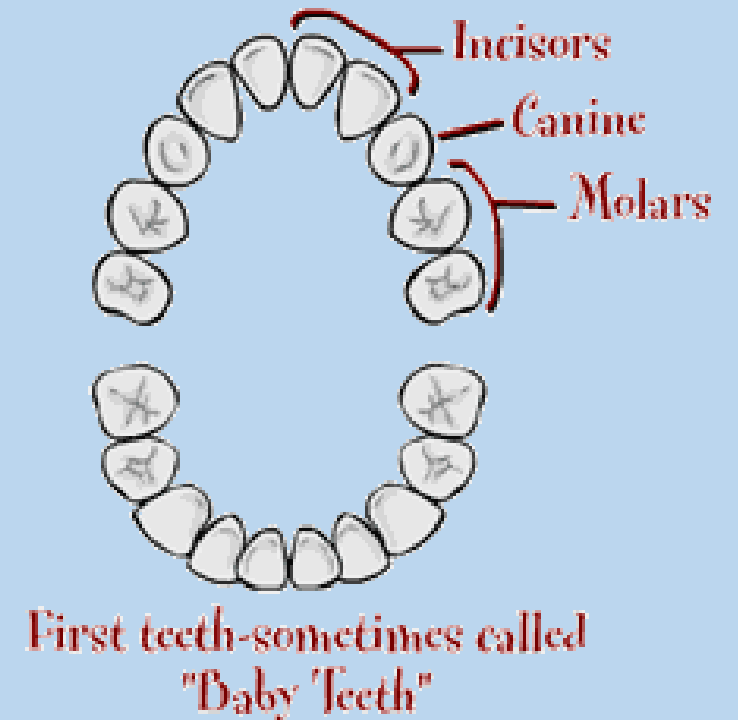
WALT: Identify different types of teeth and their jobs

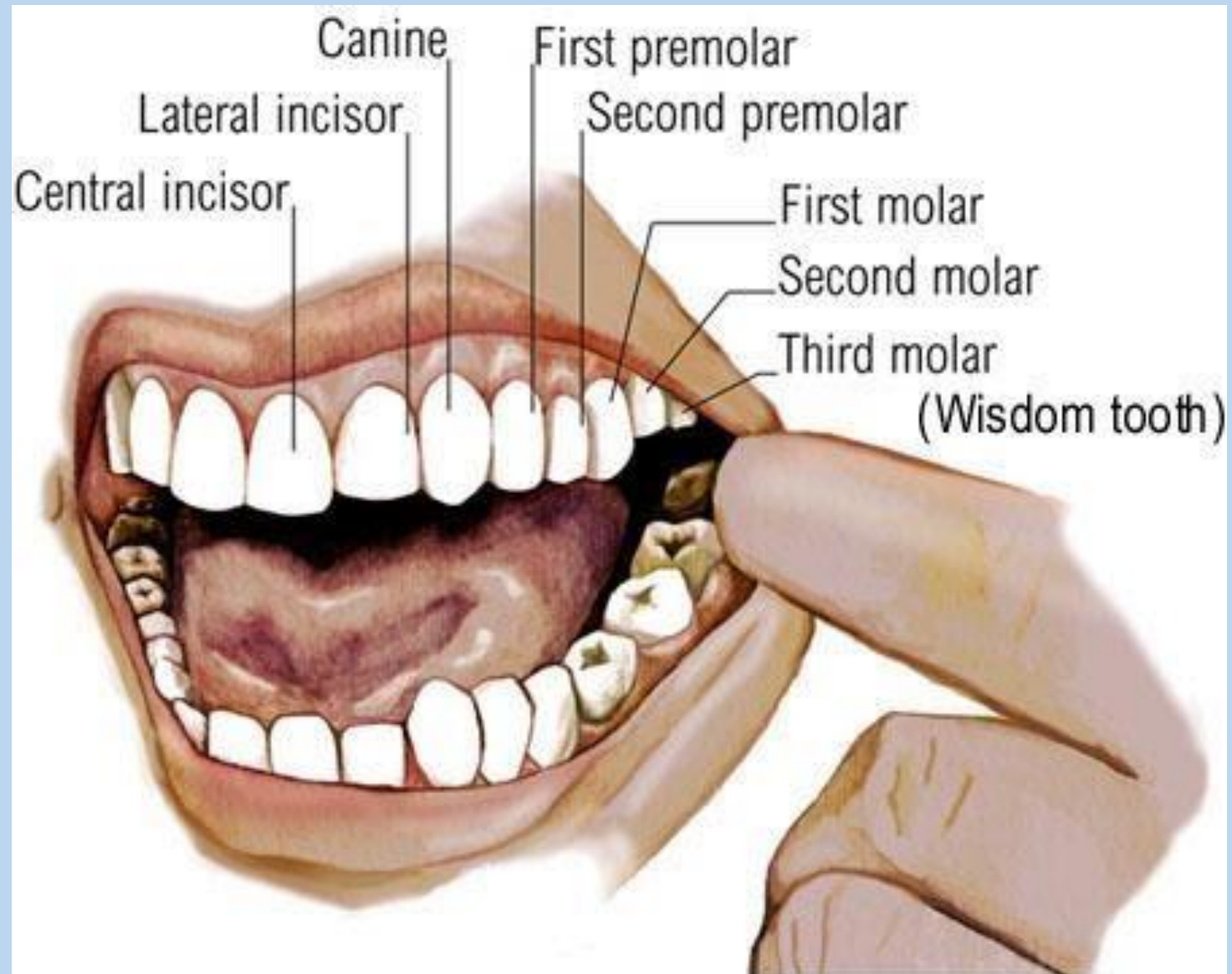


There are four different types of teeth

- Incisors
- Canines
- Pre-molar
- Molar

Teeth are made from a hard substance called enamel.





The Jobs of our Teeth

Incisors

I remember this like 'scissors' as they **cut** into the food.

Canines

Canines **tear** food, think of the word canine it resembles a dog.

Pre-molars

The role of the pre-molar is to **rip** and crush food, they have a flat biting surface.

Molars

The molars are located right at the back of the mouth and are used for **chewing** food, ready for swallowing.

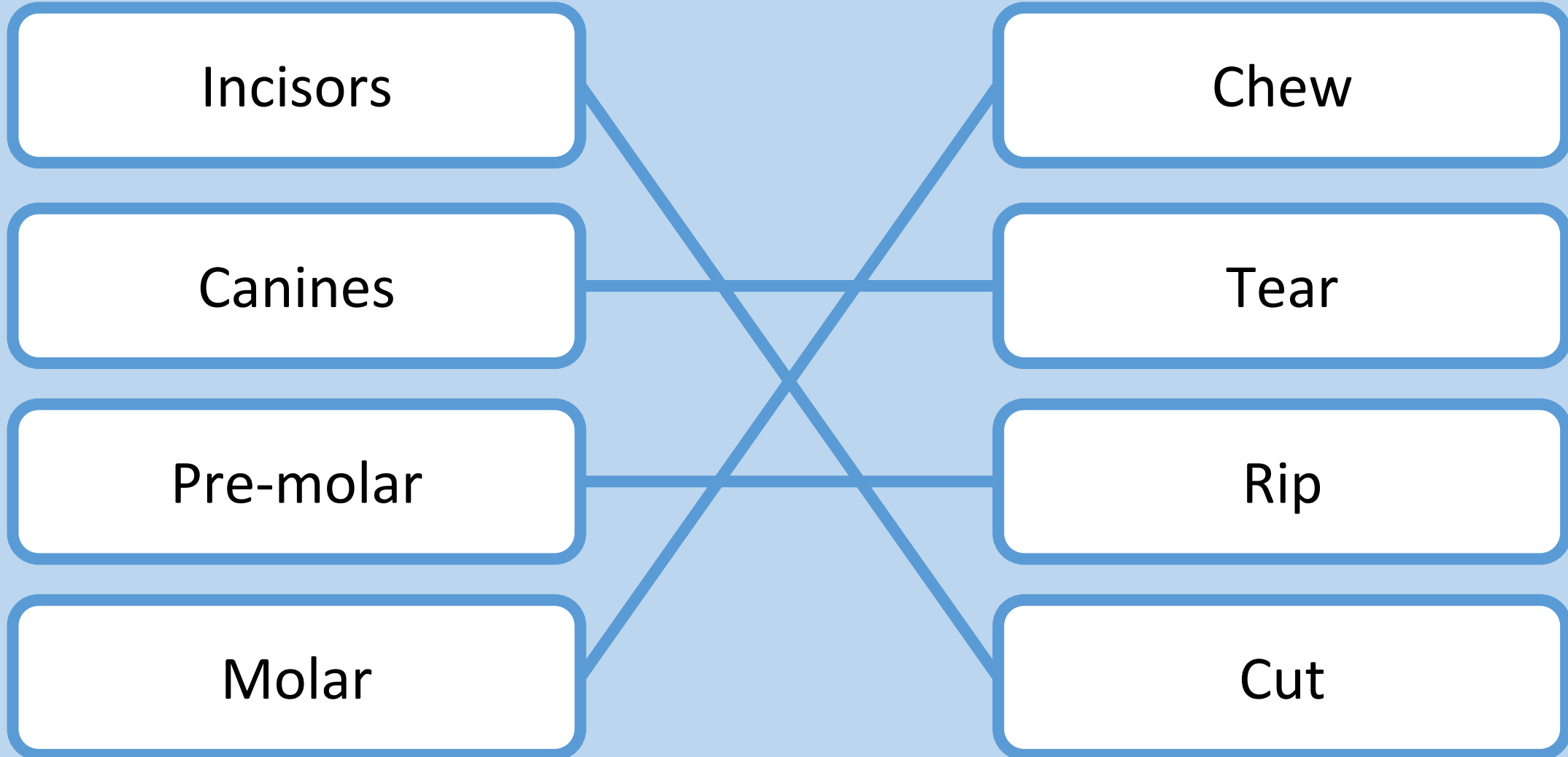
