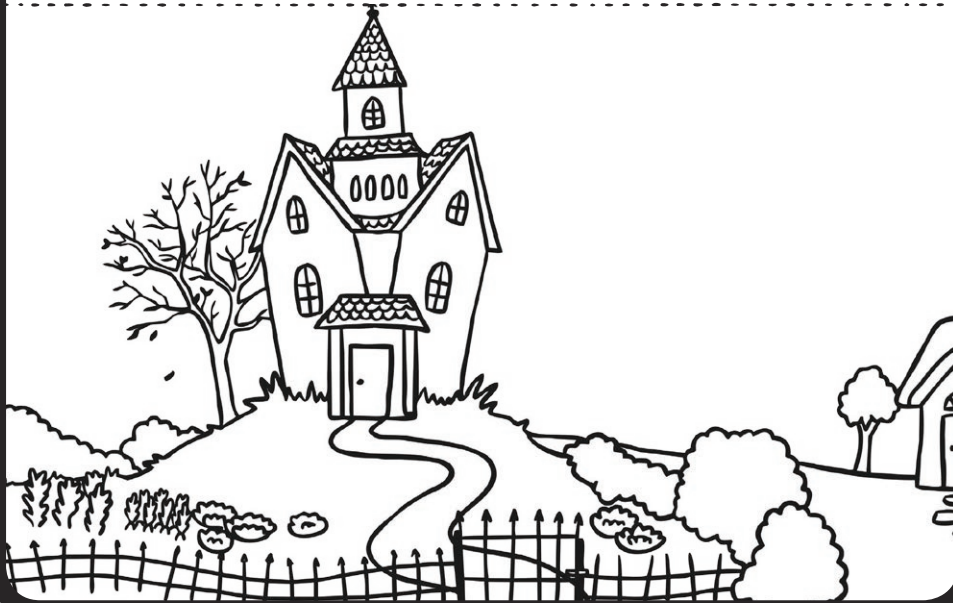

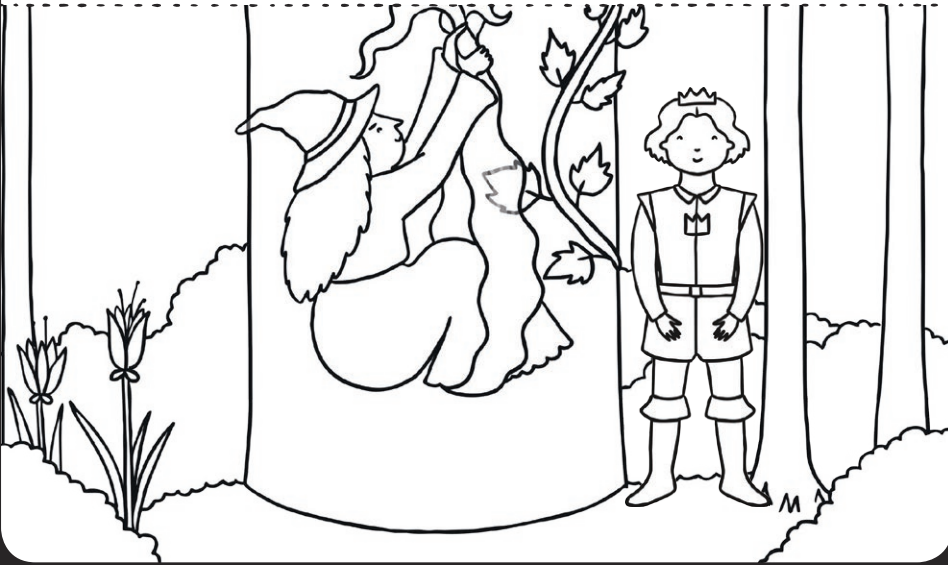

One day, a handsome prince found the tower in the forest. He watched the witch come to the tower and climb Rapunzel's hair.



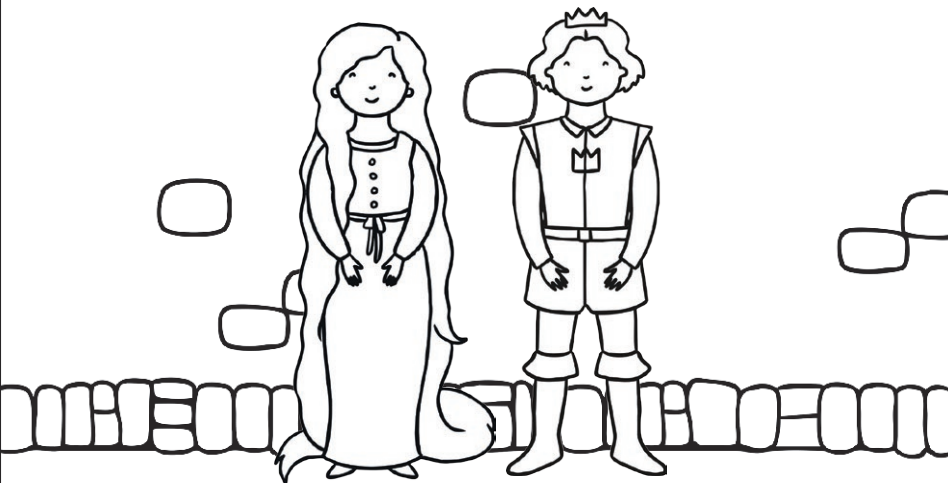

The prince visited Rapunzel every day. When the witch found out, she was angry.



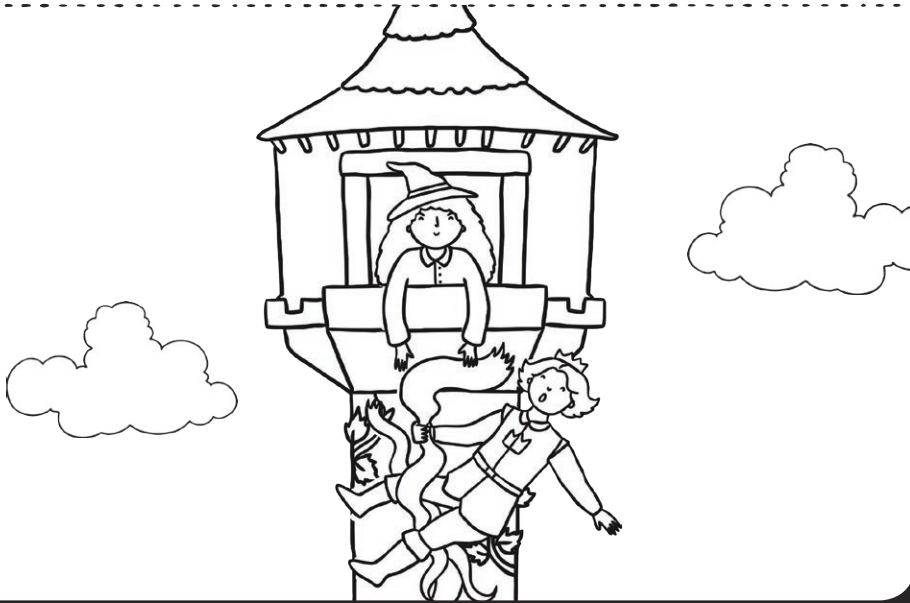

The witch tricked the prince and threw him out of the tower.



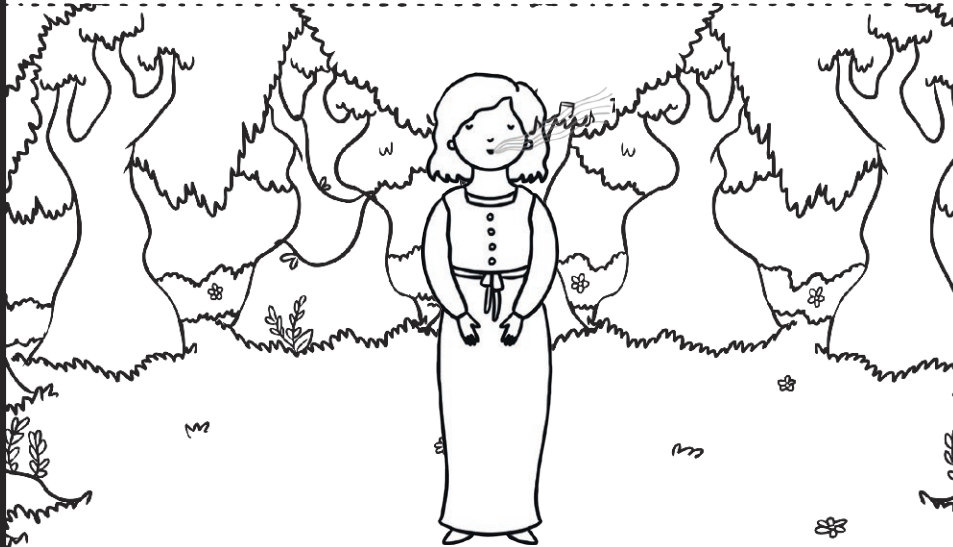
