## Re: UKS2 Visit to Warner Brothers Studio London

Dear Parent and Carers,

On **Friday 20th March 2026** we are delighted to confirm that we will be visiting The Making of Harry Potter Tour at Warner Bros Studios, London. This will be an exciting day looking at the costumes, amazing sets and intricate props used during the making of the films. We will also have the opportunity to take part in a number of interactive experiences including taking green screen pictures of the children riding broomsticks and a STEM based classroom lesson.

All children are required to wear school uniform including a school jumper/cardigan. We will be travelling by coach, departing from Highlands Drive **promptly at 8.30am and returning at approximately 5.00pm** (updates of our ETA will be sent out on the day). The children will not need anything to eat or drink on the coach. No sweets please. A packed lunch will be required including a named refillable water bottle (please do not include cans or fizzy drinks). We would suggest you also pack a healthy snack for when we arrive.

If your child requires travel sickness tablets please administer them before school in the morning and give the ones for the return journey to the class teacher in a named envelope with full instructions written on the front.

In order for your child to attend these activities **you must give permission via the School Gateway App**. The total cost for this trip will be **£37.50 per child** to cover the cost of the activities, entry fees and transport. In line with the Education Reform Act of 1988 (Section 118 (2), this amount can only be asked for as a voluntary donation and will not prejudice any child's attendance. However, I must stress that if enough donations are not received then the activities will have to be cancelled. The school does not receive funding for activities of this nature. If parents are unable to make **any** voluntary contribution because of financial difficulties, please discuss this with Mrs Hewer. If your child is unable to attend an activity due to illness, then the cost of the activity will be reimbursed.
