What's been happening in our school...?



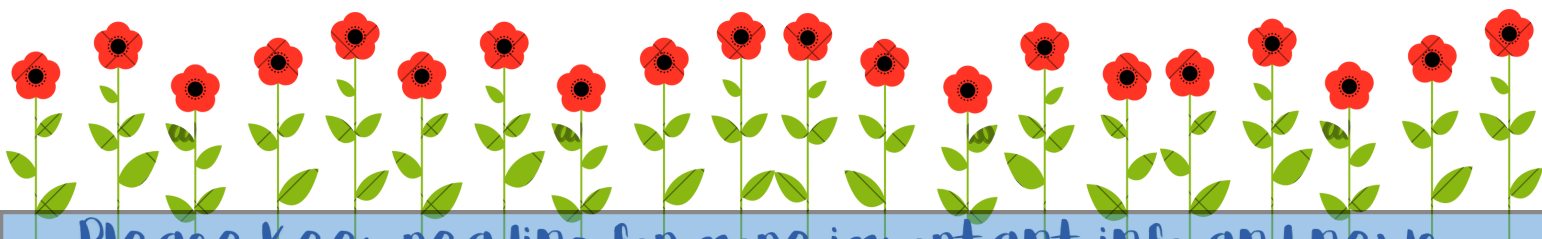
A few words from our Headteacher Mr Brown:

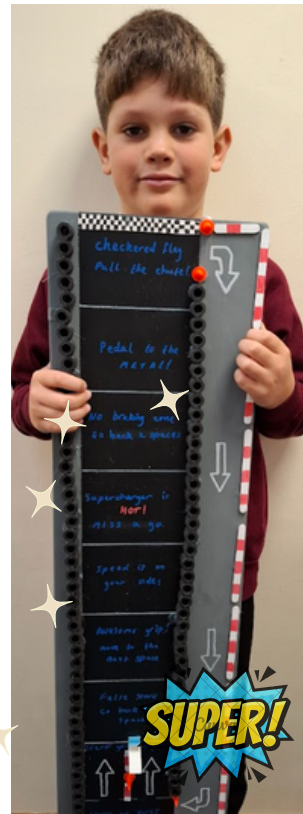

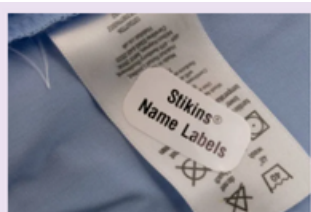
